

Ways to Leave Your Legacy

- Add a bequest to your will or trust
- Direct your IRA or other retirement accounts to UCHS Foundation
- Name UCHS Foundation as a beneficiary to a Life Insurance policy
- Purchase a Life Insurance policy to benefit UCHS Foundation
- Purchase a Charitable Gift Annuity (CGA) and receive income during your lifetime
- Donate Real Estate, Jewelry, Automobile or other in-kind items

Other Donations Might Include

- **Family Named Endowments** – available for a gift of \$100,000 or more. Paperwork is required before death.
- **Restrict a gift to the Innovation Fund** – which provides financial support for new ideas, devices, or methods. Funds will be used to support the not-for-profit mission of UCHS and position the organization as a leader and innovator around the most challenging issues facing seniors today and into the future.
